

Update for January 25, 2022

Russell County COVID-19 Update

Total positive cases since tracking began: 1,793—Increase of 110 cases since January 18, 2022

Cumulative number of positive cases for January 2022 (current): 267

Active and in Isolation as of today: 121

Recovered cases: 1,640

Hospitalized (current): 2

Deaths: 32

Average age of positive test for the month of January: 40.6

Age range for January: 2 months-101 years old

Cumulative positive rate for week January 16-January 22, 2022: 28.5%

Cumulative positivity rate for current week (January 23-January 29, 2022): 34.6%

Cumulative positivity rate for January 2022: 27.9%

Breakthrough infections December 2020—January 25, 2022 (infections after vaccination): 214—Increase by 22

Breakthrough rate by vaccine type: As of January 18, 2022, the percentage rate by vaccine:

- Moderna—3.4%
- Johnson & Johnson—9.0%
- Pfizer—3.4%

Positivity rate for positive cases that are not vaccinated for January 2022: 53.9%

The health department continues to provide the 3 different COVID vaccines. Call for an appointment. Boosters are necessary as studies have shown that immunity does wane. Individuals are now considered fully vaccinated IF they have received a booster. It may not prevent illness, but studies have shown that it prevents severe illness and hospitalization.

Here's what is going on within the state of Kansas:

Total Cases (as of 1/24/22): 695,675—increase by 14,270 since January 21

Total Deaths (as of 1/24/22): 7,336—increase by 17 deaths since January 21

Trend January 17—January 24:

- New cases in one week: 74,402
- Average of new cases per day over the last week: 10,628
- Total new deaths: 174
- Average of deaths per day: 25

Russell County rank as of January 24, 2022: 61

The breakdown shows:

- Vaccination rate—44% (rank 84)
- Average number of COVID cases—129/100k (rank 52)
- Average number of COVID tests given—1113/100k (rank 32)
