**F. Cooperative Agreement with Victoria for Softball and Baseball**

Mr. Perez reported USD 407 entered a two year cooperative agreement with Victoria USD 432 for softball and baseball during the 2023-2024 school year. This is the second year of the agreement that will be revisited next year for discussion on the continuation of the cooperative agreement.

**G. KASB June Board Policy Updates - Second Reading**

**H. Personnel Handbook - First Reading**

Mrs. Reinhardt made a motion to approve the Personnel Handbook with a change in the following language:

- page 41 ... In the administration of standardized tests **and/or state assessments**, licensed employees (teachers, administrators, and other shall not, and ...
- page 57 ... Russell **Junior-Senior** High School students must comply with the RJSHS Drug, Alcohol, and Tobacco Abuse Policy outlined in the District Handbook.

Mrs. Waymaster seconded the motion. Motion carried 6 – 0.

Mr. Mai moved, and Mrs. Reinhardt seconded a motion to amend the District Handbook to include the junior high in the drug/tobacco testing policies. Motion carried 6 – 0.

**I. Transportation Update**

Mr. Perez and Ms. Evans, Transportation Director, continue working with the insurance provider to determine the status of vehicles in the fleet following the storm in May 2024. Ms. Evans has scheduled repairs for vehicles cleared by the insurance adjuster.

Mr. Perez recommended adding an activity bus to the fleet to accommodate activities. The bus would replace the activity bus totaled in an accident. Bid specifications were shared noting a Request for Proposal must be sent out due to the cost of the bus.

Mr. Wedel made a motion to put out a Request for Proposal with specifications as presented for a new activity bus. Mrs. Myers seconded the motion. Motion carried 6 – 0.

**J. 8th Grade Promotion**

Discussion was held on the future of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade promotion celebration now that grades 7 - 8 have been combined with grades 9 – 12 into one facility. Consensus of the Board of Education is to recognize the students' accomplishments as part of the school day instead of a separate evening event.



**K. Board of Education Breakfast**

The Board of Education breakfast is scheduled for August 7, 2024. Dr. Ellis will work to organize the breakfast.

**L. Exterior Door Bids - Bickerdyke Elementary School**

Only one bid from Access Control Systems for \$53,525 was received for the door replacement at Bickerdyke Elementary School. Mr. Perez recommended delaying approval of the bid since the price is good for 60 days. Discussion followed.

Mrs. Reinhardt made a motion to approve the bid for \$53,525 to replace the east and south doors at Bickerdyke Elementary School. Mr. Mai seconded the motion. Motion carried 6 – 0.

**M. District Office and Driscoll Building**

Mr. Perez reported there are no barriers for liquidating the District Office located at 802 N. Main and the Driscoll Building located at 124 E 8<sup>th</sup> since legislation now states school districts can sell buildings that were never attendance centers without waiting for the State of Kansas to have the first opportunity at the property.

Mrs. Waymaster made a motion to clean out and sell the District Office and Driscoll Building. Mrs. Reinhardt seconded the motion. Motion carried 6 – 0.

**N. Simpson Elementary School Parking Lot**

Completion status of the parking lot located to the south of Simpson Elementary School was discussed. Mr. Mai reported the parking lot would be completed by the end of July.

**O. Russell Junior-Senior High School Electricity**

Mr. Perez visited with Joe from Trane to discuss the Russell Junior-Senior High School electrical upgrade. Further review of the drawings is needed to determine what encompasses an electrical upgrade vs a mechanical upgrade at Russell Junior-Senior High School. Discussion was tabled until the August meeting.
